



**Immaculata Catholic School
Financial Aid Policy
2018-2019**

Immaculata Catholic School has a financial aid program that is available to qualified candidates. Financial Aid is offered to accepted students based on financial need, the availability of funds, and the following criteria.

1. All families applying for financial aid must fill out a form from TADS (Tuition Aid Data Services). Forms are available online at: www.tuitionaid.com. **Deadline** for applying for financial aid is **March 15th, 2018**
2. Parents applying for Financial Aid need to specify their involvement in parish ministries and/or involvement in school activities on either the Parish Subsidy form or written and enclosed with registration form. They must clearly list their plans for the school year in which the financial aid is being requested.
3. Every parent is required to contribute a certain amount towards their child(ren)'s tuition. The financial aid amount and parent contribution amount will be recommended by the Financial Aid Committee and is sent to the Pastor for his review and approval.
4. New students accepted into Immaculata Catholic School are eligible for financial aid depending upon the funds available. Financial aid priority is given to currently enrolled students.

DESIGNATED SCHOLARSHIPS: Students and families must meet the requirements based on criteria determined by the donor.
